

Practical rules for the use of floodlights based on the Club

With a flourishing membership and coaching programme there is inevitable congestion on the courts during the winter months. The following rules are designed to give all members the opportunity to play without waiting too long:

- There is a set limit of 60 minutes (2 token's 1 hour) play time. Tokens are available to purchase at £1 each from Mike Buck/Robert Wedlake/Bob Lawton during breaks at coaching/social times but please do not interrupt play to request some.
- Members arriving and wishing to play should indicate to those on-court that they wish to play and put their token on the meter to reserve the next slot.
- Play should commence on either the half or full hour, with players arriving 5-10 minutes early to signal their intentions.
- The lights should not be allowed to go out as they take time to cool before coming on again, so members are able to put more than 2 tokens into the meter. Should those on-court having played for 60 minutes then be vacating the court with another 30 minutes in the meter, they should claim a replacement token from those arriving.
- Should arriving members find all courts occupied and not wish to wait for a vacant court they may pay for a floodlit court at the Leisure Centre and claim reimbursement with their receipt.
- These rules are for courts available outside of the regular court bookings for matches, tournaments, and coaching – see schedules on the notice boards and website -and for Senior Mix –Ins/Juniors:
 - Tuesday 5.30-8.30
 - Wednesday 9.30-12.30
 - Friday 9.30-12.30
 - Sunday 9.30-12.3
 - Junior Night – Fridays 5-7 pm

Any additional reserved court sessions must be agreed by committee.
